***Die Wahrnehmung der Landschaft anderte sich im 20. Jahrhundert dramatisch - schon durch die Globalisierung und die neuen Umweltbewegungen. Den Vermessungstechnikern und Kartographen kam eine zentrale Rolle in diesen Prozessen zu, da die Darstellung der Landschaft auf Karten oder in Geographischen Informationssystemen populare Vorstellungen der Umwelt prägt. Der Vergleich zwischen Deutschland und den USA demonstriert, dass in beiden Landern dieselben Prozesse wirksam waren, die einen fundamentalen Wandel im menschlichen Raum- und Landschaftsverständnis bewirkten. Sie trafen allerdings auf unterschiedliche nationale kartographische Stile, welche die Reaktionen auf die technischen und gesellschaftlichen Wandlungsprozesse im 20. Jahrhundert modifizierten. Die Studie verknüpft somit Aspekte der Umwelt- und Raumgeschichte mit solchen der Technik- und Wissenschaftsgeschichte und integriert sie in die allgemeine Kulturgeschichte des 20. Jahrhunderts.***

The margravian court astronomer Simon Marius, was involved in all of the new observations made with the recently invented

telescope in the early part of the seventeenth century. He also discovered the Moons of Jupiter in January 1610, but lost the priority dispute with Galileo Galilei, because he missed to publish his findings in a timely manner. The history of astronomy neglected Marius for a long time, finding only the apologists for the Copernican system worthy of attention. In contrast the papers presented on the occasion of the Simon Marius Anniversary Conference 2014, and collected in this volume, demonstrate that it is just this struggle to find the correct astronomical system that makes him particularly interesting. His research into comets, sunspots, the Moons of Jupiter and the phases of Venus led him to abandon the Ptolemaic system and adopt the Tyconic one. He could not take the final step to heliocentricity but his rejection was based on empirical arguments of his time. This volume presents a translation of the main work of Marius and shows the current state of historical research on Marius.
