volume's "Contrary States" are sometimes signalled by patently repeated or contrasted titles: in *Innocence*, *Infant Joy*, in *Experience*, *Infant Sorrow*; in *Innocence*, *The Lamb*, in *Experience*, *The Fly* and *The Tyger*. The stark simplicity of poems such as *The Chimney Sweeper* and

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The Little Black Boy display Blake's acute sensibility to the realities of poverty and exploitation that accompanied the "Dark Satanic Mills" of the Industrial Revolution.
